

William D. Modell Community Service Award




THE FLOATING HOSPITAL

Our Modell Community Service Honoree, The Floating Hospital, has provided first rate medical services to New York City's most vulnerable families for over 150 years. Today, they provide healthcare, health education, social support and the delivery of necessities to the city's families living in homeless shelters and domestic-violence safe houses. They also serve LIC's public housing and low income residents. This past year, they played a heightened role with COVID testing, vaccinations, clinics and more.

About LIC

Long Island City is a uniquely mixed-use neighborhood. While this year has been incredibly difficult, the diversity and people behind our community position LIC for a strong recovery in the year ahead.

Community Development

Guided by the findings of the 2016 LIC Comprehensive Plan, LICP continues to build upon the success of existing work in fostering emerging industries, enriching the public realm, and connecting people with the neighborhood's unique commercial, recreational and cultural assets through our wayfinding system. LICP fosters community development through two strategies: capturing and sharing crucial data and resources and facilitating projects in the public realm. Most importantly, LICP builds connections between LIC's greatest asset—the unique and diverse population of people who live, work and create here.

LIC Local

Since its launch in 2019, our smart wayfinding system, LIC Local (formerly known as LIC Compass) has captured more than 3,000 unique QR code scans and 38,000 mobile web page views. With 200 signs deployed throughout LIC, we are able to connect with thousands of people and share up-to-date information on local businesses, upcoming events, art installations, and more.

LIC Area Arts Program

After pausing the program due to COVID, LICP is moving full steam ahead with an exciting portfolio of new public art installations throughout LIC, including murals, sculptures, and digital artwork Community-driven and locally-focused, our public art projects highlight the talent and creativity of one of New York City's most vibrant art

Business Survey

Earlier this year, LICP conducted our 3rd biennial business and organization survey to capture key data on the state of our community. Hundreds of businesses responded, sharing information on their needs, workforce composition, and the challenges that the business community has faced throughout the pandemic. Preliminary results demonstrate that LIC's geography and unique transportation amenities continue to make it a desirable locale for businesses and workers alike. As 2020 Census Data is made available in the coming months, LICP will use this information to engage with policymakers and stakeholders on the short term and long term needs of our business community.

Moving Forward

Last year, LICP published its Neighborhood Snapshot: Decade in Review, highlighting the tremendous progress that we have achieved together in building a vibrant, mixed-use, and mutually supportive neighborhood over the past ten years. Forthcoming Census data will confirm what we already know to be true: LIC is one of New York City's fastest growing in the nation and also the most authentically mixed-use. While we remain vigilant against COVID, we are looking forward to emerging from the pandemic more resilient than ever.





Our website licqns.com/economicdevelopment includes many layers of neighborhood information, including: Development Maps providing real-time data on the neighborhood's growth, Neighborhood Snapshots on the area, including development statistics, area assets, major employers and institutions, and a compilation of Market Reports on LIC produced by industry leaders.

Business Improvement District

Managed by the Long Island City Partnership, the LIC BID provides supplementary sanitation and visitor services within the District, and carries out community development and marketing initiatives that benefit the greater neighborhood. Created in 2005, the original LIC BID encompassed the commercial corridors along Queens Plaza and Jackson Avenue to Court Square. It has since been expanded to include the commercial corridors continuing along Jackson Avenue, Vernon Boulevard, and 44th Drive.

Beautification

We have an extensive horticulture program where we plant and maintain tulips, begonias, hanging lamp post flower baskets and solar powered tree pit lights throughout the BID. Additionally the BID maintains the medians along Jackson Avenue and partners with the NYC Department of Parks & Recreation to enhance and beautify the Queens Plaza Greenway and Dutch Kills Green.

Sanitation

The BID contracts with Streetplus to provide supplemental on-street services such as sidewalk sweeping, bagging trash, monthly graffiti removal and snow and ice shoveling in the winter months. Throughout COVID-19 our sanitation team has expanded its cleaning efforts to thoroughly clean off all on-street furniture, open surfaces including but not limited to, benches, parking meters, and trash receptacles. Equipped with disposable sanitary gloves and face masks at all times, they have been crucial in keeping the community as clean and safe as possible.

Safe & Supportive

Through the year we have engaged with both of NYPD's 108th and 114th Precincts, and other NYPD leaders, to discuss crime issues and strategies on how to work in partnership to create a safer neighborhood. This included frequent roundtable meetings with local businesses, community members and property owners to discuss community events and safety tips. We have continued regular district walkthroughs with Breaking Ground, the city-designated homeless outreach organization, and the Department of Homeless Services and Department of Mental Health and Hygiene to help connect those in need to resources and support.

Community

This year we hosted two annual community-wide volunteer days: a Fall community planting day of tulip bulbs throughout the neighborhood and a Spring begonia planting day with local community members and employees from the VOREA Group. Thank you to everyone who came out to help



This year we started an exciting initiative, the LIC Community Gift Card, a digital gift card that keeps local dollars local, and can be used at any of the 60+ businesses in the neighborhood that opt in to participate.






Business Assistance & LIC Industrial Business Zone

Since our founding in 1979, we have provided one-on-one assistance to businesses in the greater LIC area on a wide variety of issues, including: financing and incentives, real estate, operational issues, energy savings, staff training, and more. We also manage the **LIC** Industrial Business Zone (LICIBZ). established in 2006 by the City to protect existing manufacturing districts and encourage industrial growth citywide. In addition, we are working with a group of businesses and stakeholders to address and improve the operational challenges of the IBZ area south and east of Sunnyside Yard.

This year, our team continues to act as a lead source of support for businesses applying to the different federal, state and city level pandemic relief programs, as

well as grant assistance from private sources. To date in 2021, we have helped 24 businesses successfully apply for financing assistance totaling \$5.6 million.



Annual Real Estate Breakfast


